Meeting started at 7:05

1. Introductions
2. Agenda Adjustments and Public Comments

None were added.
3. Public Meeting – Alternatives Presentation on the Exit 6 Park and Ride Project

Gary explained that further evaluation has been conducted on all the Alternatives. There were comments on accommodating electric vehicle charging, bike lockers, and pedestrian features on any of the Sites. VTrans acknowledged that it would. Site 1 was recently sold, and it is unknown what the buyer plans for the site. Site 2 has a lot of constraints, and can’t meet future needs of the lot. Site 3 can mostly use State ROW, and has the the adjacent land owner’s support. Site 4 has a lot of environmental impacts. The TAC commented on the safety concerns crossing traffic on VT 63. Bob made a motion to recommend Site 3, if the traffic safety concerns are addressed. Frank seconded the motion. VTrans acknowledged that it would. It was discussed whether a backup Site be recommended, but it was discussed that if the first Site didn’t work, VTrans would come back. The motion passed. VTrans will now work on the Conceptual Plans.
4. Approve September TAC Minutes

Frank motioned, Don seconded, & the TAC voted to approve the minutes.
5. Update on Plan Central Vermont.

Staff explained that the Commission asked that all the Transportation Sections be put in one document, that the Chapter be made more concise, and that it needed to be reformatted. Staff explained how this would be accomplished. The TAC offered suggestions.
