Vermont Agency of Transportation

M. Boomhower & K. Robie gave an overview of current AOT programing and budgets. This included discussion of safety trends, road way conditions and projected revenue sources. The VTransparency Public Information Portal was also introduced. The presenters took questions from Commissioners.

Public Hearing – Transportation Alternatives Grant Application

B. Wernecke made a motion to move into public hearing. G. Malek seconded. Motion carried.

The Vermont River Conservancy would like CVRPC to act as applicant and fiscal agent for a shared use path project that VRC will manage and carry out. N. Pollack & S. Libby explained the history of the segment of the North Branch of the Winooski River along the old Rt. 2 roadbed on the Worcester-Elmore town boundary. The headwaters there are pristine and the old roadbed offers the opportunity for an excellent recreational shared use path. The area also suffers from stormwater runoff issues, and redesign of the path provides an opportunity to mitigate some of these issues. The project will start with an application for a scoping study in the magnitude of \$10-20,000.

S. Lotspeich made a motion to leave public hearing. R. Krauth seconded. Motion carried. There was no further discussion.

Statewide Property Parcel Mapping Program

L. Pelch explained the purpose of the program to provide parcel mapping and parcel mapping updates for municipalities to bring parcel data to a consistent standard that can be utilized by municipalities, private entities, state agencies, regional planning commissions and more. The project is funded by the Agency of Transportation. The project will result in more accurate parcel and tax maps for municipalities, association and analysis of Grand List data via mapping, streamlined Right of Way research, cross-sector land use planning applications, and many more uses. Towns which would like to participate in the first round of updates should contact Leslie Pelch or CVRPC. The program will also set the stage for an ongoing program for maintenance of parcel data.

Brownfields Advisory Committee Rules of Procedure
