Recommendations will identify tools, resources and collaborations that will be needed to implement certain policies.

More targeted goals and policies will be developed based on existing conditions and trends analysis.

Most of the public facility- or service- related policies are general statements of support or encouragement and are not directive or actionable. There is no discussion of or strategies for financing public facilities and services.	Inventory and narrative of 2008 Plan will be expanded to the extent possible based on regional stakeholder input and on local information regarding condition and capacity.
