7. Public Meeting on the East Montpelier US 2/VT 14 Intersection Bridge Project

Vtrans presented why the project was needed, challenges, details of the design, and schedule. The design is 65% complete. The ROW is done and they are in the middle of designing utility changes. There will be a 40 day closure of the VT 14 Bridge, with day and night construction. No construction will take place in the AM & PM peak hours. In 2016, they will do prep. Work. In 2017, the Utilities will move their infrastructure. In 2018, major construction will occur, with the closure in the Fall. Two lane traffic will be maintained on US 2 & VT 14, except during the closure. The project will use "Ride and Slide" construction methods. They will build the new deck next to the existing bridge. When complete, the new deck will carry the traffic, and they will remove the old bridge & build the new supports. When done, the closure will occur, and they will slide the new deck on to the new supports. VTrans will coordinate with emergency services, and the schools. There will be an official detour for trucks, and compensation agreements will be made for local traffic using back road bypasses. VTrans will implement measures to minimize effects of night work, on residents. There will be weekly reports on a website, emails, facebook, and twitter.
