1. Introductions
2. Agenda Adjustments and Public Comments
Agenda items 3, and 4 were added.
3. Update on the pedestrian and intersection projects in Plainfield Village
Bob A. explained that a kick off meeting was held in September, on the pedestrian bridge project sidewalk project, which connects the Lower Village with US 2 and the Town Hall/Opera House. Another kick off meeting was held on the US 2 / Main St. Intersection, with the consultant Stantec. Project history and constrains were discussed.
4. Vermont Road Users Rally for Safety
Staff announced the Rally, which is a result of fatalities on the roads, particularly for bicyclists that have occurred this year. The TAC recommended that all bicyclist be required to use day/night lights, in the front and rear of the bicycle.
