COVID-19 Supplies and Expenses Grants for Early Childhood Education Programs

The Vermont Association for the Education of Young Children is offering Vermont early childhood education programs grants of up to \$500 to help offset COVID-19 expenses. They aim to get extra funding to programs as quickly as possible

through as simple a process as possible.

There is a pot of \$25,000 to distribute in increments of up to \$500 per program. Grants are distributed first come, first served, until funding runs out. **Applications close July 10.**

Economic Recovery Grants Application Process Opens on July 6

ACCD's Economic Recovery Grants application process will open on Monday, July 6. Businesses who collect Rooms and Meals Tax or Sales and Use tax should apply for a grant through the Department of Taxes. All other private businesses and non-profits should apply through ACCD. The maximum grant ceiling amount is \$50,000.
