### **Potential Factors to Consider for Committee Nominations**

- Are there committees for which a balance of perspectives is very important?
- 2. Match those who want to serve on a committee with a committee they are interested in
- 3. Integrate new commissioners on a committee to build ties with the Commission's work.
- 4. To the extent possible, avoid placing a commissioner and an alternate from the same town on the same committee.
- 5. When possible, use continuity of members to maintain institutional knowledge.
- 6. When possible, introduce new views and develop commissioners by integrating new committee members.
- 7. People who only want to serve on one committee should only be asked to serve on once committee.
- 8. If there is sufficient overall interest in serving, limit the number of committees to two (possibly three)/person, so that other commissioners also can serve.
