What is the Basin Water Quality Council (BWQC)?

CVRPC, as the Clean Water Service Provider (CWSPs) for the Winooski Basin, must convene a BWQC. The Winooski BWQC will establish policy and guide decisions on project prioritization and selection of clean water projects for funding. The CWSP will oversee identification, implementation, and operation of those projects to achieve pollution reduction targets for the Winooski Basin.

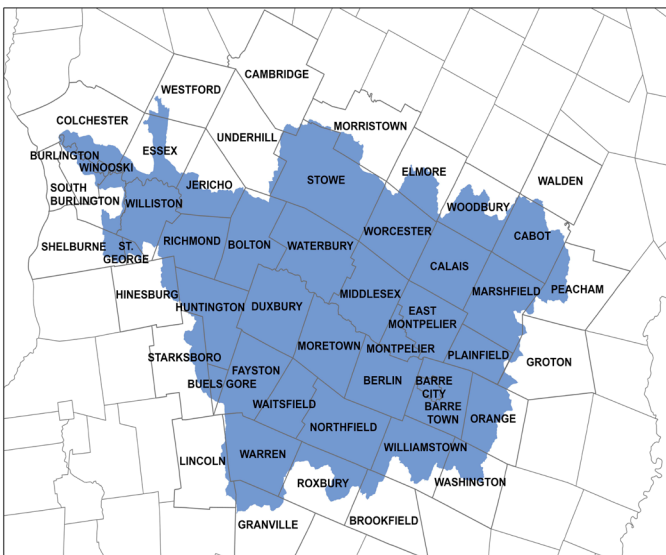
BWQC Start Up Timeline

- January 2022: BWQC empaneled
- February 2022: First BWQC meeting
- February to April 2022: Develop meeting rules, policies, training
- BWQC meets quarterly
