### **Regional Issues**

A) MyRide Transit Service- Presentation by Christopher Damiani of GMT. Chris presented on how the two year pilot program was going for the first year and how GMT will be doing a reeducation campaign with how to ride materials, a new survey, outreach for the legislatures, and continuing to update the service.

### **TAC Member Round Table** A) Local Concerns Including Project Updates and Other Issues

Bob Atchinson from Plainfield gave an update on the Route 2 and Main Street project. The pedestrian bridge is ongoing. Holes in the deck of the existing bridge have been identified. There is concern that salt will get into these holes during the winter. According to VTrans the deck and substructure are in great condition but the Town is worried that it won't last long since there has been a lot of equipment use which has pounded the deck, and the Town feels that VTrans needs to plug and patch before more damage occurs. VTrans has also removed the railing on the south side of the bridge.

B) Road Crew Staffing-Staff shared that at the November TPI meeting that Vermont Local Roads was putting together a training and presentations to be shared at Selectboard meetings, TACs, and schools to encourage people to apply to Town Road Crew positions since Towns are struggling to find help.
