Updated Slow the Spread Recommendations for Moving Ash Materials

Based on the extent of Vermont's current <u>EAB Infested Area</u> – covering nearly 2/3 of the state - the <u>recommendations for moving ash material</u> have been updated to allow for greater movement of low-risk ash

material in Vermont while providing greater protection of uninfested trees and forests. The previous recommendations were location-based and applied to moving ash material from the <u>EAB Infested Area</u>. The <u>updated recommendations</u> are condition-based and apply to moving ash wood visibly infested with EAB. While the <u>EAB Infested Area Map shows</u> that EAB is widespread, **visibly infested trees are still rare** in Vermont. You can help by following the updated <u>Slow the Spread Recommendations</u> for moving all ash material in Vermont: **there is still a lot of EAB spread to slow.**

The EAB flight season starts on June 1st and goes through September 30th. During this time of year, EAB will be emerging from infested ash trees, logs, and firewood and seeking new host trees and mates. Moving ash materials during the flight season could spread EAB to currently uninfested areas. Therefore, there are more stringent recommendations for moving visibly infested ash materials in the updated Slow the Spread Recommendations to protect these areas, including delaying harvesting and not moving untreated ash until after flight season (October 1st). Slowing the spread of EAB will allow us more time to prepare and respond, but we will all need to work together. If you think you have found EAB or an infested ash tree, report it! Having more information about where EAB is around the state will help all of us in managing the pes

Request for Proposals for Accounting Services - Reissued

The Central Vermont Regional Planning Commission (CVRPC) is requesting proposals from qualified individuals or firms for accounting services. Services provided through this contract will assist CVRPC to perform full charge bookkeeping including preparing for and participating in an annual audit from July 2022 – October 31, 2023. If requested, services also may include training financial management staff, adapting and strengthening internal controls, and updates to the existing financial system. CVFiber Construction Request for Proposals - Construction Services

CVFiber intends to construct approximately 400 miles of fiber communication infrastructure over a 12-month period and 1,200 miles over the next 4 years, with a minimum aggressive target construction pace of 50 miles per month. Construction is expected to begin in September 2022.

This Request for Proposal (RFP) is issued by CVFiber to solicit proposals from interested contractors. Proposals may be for separate scopes of work or for the entire enterprise. Request for Bid: Gully Stabilization and Stormwater Mitigation at The Health Center Plainfield, Vermont

Stormwater improvements will be made by regrading the steep slope behind THC to create a stormwater settling area and constructing a riprap filter berm to slow stormwater and allow sediment to settle. Erosion in the gully will be stabilized by adding logs, coir fiber rolls, and vegetation. The project includes excavation, landscaping, and forestry. Work tasks will generally involve installation and maintenance of erosion and sediment controls; establishing site access; excavation of earth fill and hauling to an upland location; installation of heavy stone fill; cutting, moving, and installation of logs; installation of coir fiber rolls; planting of trees, shrubs, and seed; and site restoration.

The Vermont Community Foundation and the Vermont Department of Health have announced that Track Two, the second round of the recently announced Health Equity grant program, is now open. The Health Equity grant program is for community-based organizations that are working to address health disparities in Vermont. Track Two is designed primarily for organizations building internal capacity. Organizations applying for Track Two can request different kinds of technical assistance that will strengthen their organization and/or communities.

The first deadline for Track Two is 11:59 p.m. ET on July 8, 2022. Additional applications will be accepted on a rolling basis through August 31, 2022, as available funding permits. We encourage organizations to apply by July 8, 2022.
