# Recommend updates to the Rule of Procedure and Rule of Process

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<u>Rules of Procedure</u> - Staff confirmed that the changes were made to conform with the updated Bylaws. L Cattaneo asked why the first bullet was changed, staff felt the new first bullet replaced and reworded the same activity.

<u>R Wernecke made a motion to recommend the changes as presented to be approved by the Board.</u> Seconded by P Carbee. All in favor.

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<u>Rules of Process</u> – Staff confirmed these changes were presented by staff (and are not based upon changes to the Bylaws.) Discussion followed that this would make staff process easier.

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P Carbee made a motion to recommend the changes as presented to be approved by the Board.

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#### Act 250 / Section 248 Applications & Projects of Substantial Regional Impact

- a) Consider significant regional impact and conformance with regional plan for the following projects:
  - JDJ Development Company, Inc planned residential development to include five (5) existing, four (4) unit, townhouses and eight (8) proposed, four (4) unit, townhouses, for a total of fifty-two (52) units located off Rudd Farm and Olivia Drive, Barre Town.

Staff shared the presentation which included a staff recommendation. Discussion followed which included the following comments: Richardson Road with RT 302 could be a problem intersection and staff bought up a copy of the Traffic Impact Study it covers that intersection. There is no significant impacts at the intersection. The Town of Barre has approved the project, a copy of the DRB Decision was included in the Act 250 submission.

The project has already has been considered a project of SRI due to the SRI definition. It was noted that housing in this area tends to be more affordable and the project is located close to schools and existing infrastructure. And is infill between 2 existing neighborhoods. One member raised the concern that this was in the Region's Rural Land Use District and this should be recognized as well as there are a few natural resource constraints on the property (prime ag soils and some steep slopes but these are outside of the development footprint.) On member added that it is generally in conformance, and is not inconsistent.

<u>P Carbee made a motion to find the project to be substantially in conformance with the regional plan and without comment to the applicant and submit a letter to Act 250 stating so. Seconded by R Werneke. All in favor. So moved.</u>

b) Updates on the following projects:

- Lowery Road Solar LLC –4.999 MW solar project occupying 29 acres (10,295+/- solar panels) in Barre Town and Orange.

Staff gave an update and including the proposed site plan was very similar to the final one and that there was no significant changes. A Committee member indicated that based upon the construction style the development will have a lesser impact on the agricultural soils.

I Love Cows LLC –2.5 MW solar project occupying 12 acres (5,000 solar panels) of Allen Street in Barre City.

Staff gave an update based uponthe information in the meeting materials. Discussion about the wetlands, and the aesthetics. Discussion followed about whether it is SRI. Committee feels it doesn't rise to that level and the aesthetics are local impacts and the wetlands must get a State permit.

<u>P Carbee made motion that the project doesn't have SRI and therefore there is no comment. Seconded by R Werneke. All in favor. So moved.</u>
