Recently I've been chairing an effort in Moretown to develop an in-ground wastewater system for Moretown Village.

Also involved with others in Moretown along with the Town of Waterbury to bring over wastewater lines into North Moretown and Duxbury.

Currently I'm on the Moretown Planning Commission and at this time we are re-writing our town plan.

Protecting, sustaining, and restoring cold, clean water has also been my primary mission as a Trout Unlimited volunteer for over 40 years. During this time I have been the VT TU Council Chair, Chair of our local TU Chapter, MadDog TU and have organized the planting of 1000's of trees along Vermont rivers primarily here in Central Vermont. I have also been a member of the Vermont Dam Task Force and have helped and partnered on dam removal projects. I think I would bring a depth of experience to the Clean Water Advisory Committee.
