21 **Approval of Minutes**

22 J. Brabant moved to approve the December 16, 2025 minutes. D. Greason seconded. The motion  
23 passed unanimously.

25 **Utilities, Facilities and Services chapter**

26 B. Voigt presented 2 versions of the chapter – one which broke out specific topics and an alternate  
27 which had large picture goals, strategies and policies which could be applied to several different topic  
28 areas. The Committee decided they preferred the original version, while acknowledging that the  
29 resulting 18-page document was long. There was discussion of possibly breaking out “Services” as its  
30 own chapter, but that was not pursued further. There was also conversation about pulling out equity  
31 framework technical assistance throughout the entire document and including it in this chapter or  
32 possibly at the beginning of the document, rather than duplicating it in each individual goal and chapter.

34 **Energy Chapter and Related Items**

35 The energy chapter/element is separate from this chapter, and is currently an appendix to the  
36 readopted plan. There was discussion about citing of large-scale power consumers and where that  
37 belongs in the Regional Plan. The importance of the Regional Plan supporting town plans and town  
38 authority over citing was discussed. B. Voigt will review the chapter with an eye to conflicting goals.
