1 **Staff Announcements**

- 2 • CVRPC has received proposals for the Williamstown and Marshfield projects.  
3 Williamstown received one response from a qualified firm and will not need to conduct  
4 a scoring and selection process. Marshfield received two responses, and staff are  
5 currently setting up the selection process with town steering.
- 6 • CVRPC staff are conducting and continuing to schedule town consultations as part of the  
7 Regional Safety Action Plan they are creating. These consultations are intended to fill  
8 gaps in knowledge that are not covered by other available data and information  
9 sources.
- 10 • CVRPC informed TAC of the severity of price increases for materials that will impede  
11 State and Town efforts related to roadway maintenance.

14 **Discussion: Process for Non – Metropolitan Local Official Participation in the Statewide**  
15 **Transportation Planning Process**

- 16 • Matthew Arancio presented the State’s updated guidance for “Non – Metropolitan Local  
17 Official Participation in the Statewide Transportation Planning Process” which defines  
18 the role of Regional TACs and their members.
  - 19 ○ Ensuing conversation turned largely on the question of what role for TACs with  
20 VPSP2 process currently suspended.

21 **TAC Member Round Table**

- 22 • Jordan K requested information on funding sources for municipal projects. Staff agreed  
23 to share relevant documents.
- 24 • Ron K inquired about the status of the proposed crosswalk demonstration at Camp  
25 Meade in Middlesex. Staff informed that they were waiting on feedback from the recent  
26 technical review by VTrans and would keep Ron informed of project status as it evolves.
- 27 • Alice P reported on two recent serious crashes in Waitsfield Village, both involving  
28 intoxicated drivers putting their vehicles through the walls of buildings. She also  
29 updated TAC on the multiple deficient bridges that Waitsfield finds itself dealing with.
