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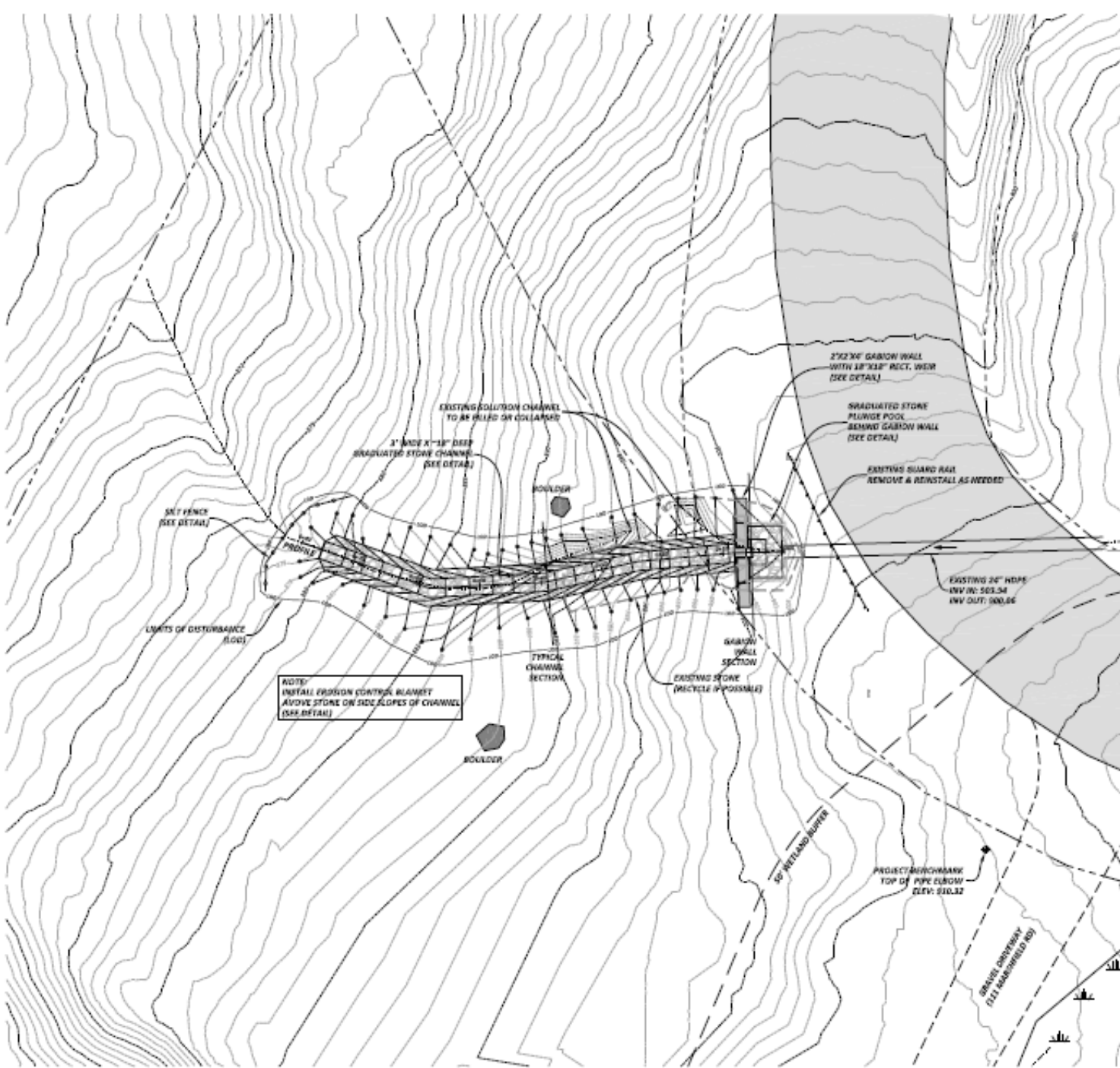

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Final Proposal Review: Gully Stabilization – Marshfield Road

- ◆ Primary Contact: Brian Voigt, CVRPC
- ◆ Project Type: Road / Stormwater Gully Stabilization – Implementation
- ◆ Project Description: This project involves the stabilization of a stormwater gully along Marshfield Road (Calais) to prevent long-term erosion at the site. The Final Design was completed with Formula Grant funding. The Town and adjacent landowners support project implementation.
- ◆ Project Deliverables:
 - ◆ P-reduction: 5.61 kg / yr
- ◆ Project Budget:
 - ◆ Formula Grant: \$56,226.15 (no match)
- ◆ Staff Recommendation: Fund this proposal
